

Important Reminders

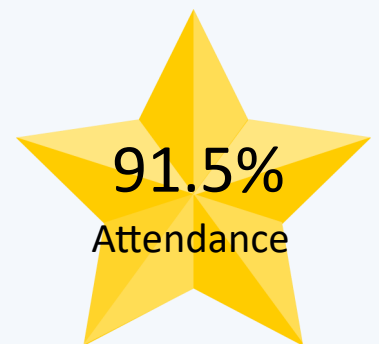
A reminder that all children should be in school and ready to start learning by **8:55am** each morning. Arriving on time helps children settle into the day positively and ensures they do not miss important learning activities.

For the safety of all pupils, staff and families, the car park gates **must not be used at any time** to enter or exit the school grounds. Please use the designated pedestrian entrances when arriving at or leaving school.

We continue to experience difficulties with school dinners not being booked in advance. To support the smooth running of the service, please ensure that your child's meal is booked through the appropriate system by **8:00am each day**.

Failure to book a meal in advance may result in a school dinner being unavailable, as accurate numbers are required to ensure sufficient meals are prepared for all children.

A reminder that all school clubs must be booked in advance. This includes Breakfast Club, After School Club and all sports clubs. Children who have not been booked onto a club may not be able to attend, as places and staffing are planned based on advance bookings.
